THE VINES and THE WINE:

This release is a blend of 2 vineyards, La Chenaie Vineyard in the Eola-Amity AVA (40%) and Croft Vineyard in the Willamette Valley AVA (60%).

Vineyards: La Chenaie Vineyard (Eola-Amity Hills AVA) & Croft Vineyard (Willamette Valley AVA). Both farmed organically.

Soil: La Chenaie: Volcanic (Jory, Ritner, Nekia)

Croft Vineyard: Sedimentary, (Bellpine)

Fermentation and Ageing: 8 neutral French oak barrels and a stainless steel barrel. 8 months elevage.

Bottled: June 2020

Numbers: pH 3.15, T.A. 7.0 g/L, Alc. 13.2%

Cases: 210 case production
